MINERVA LAKE CAMPSITE RULES

Effective APRIL 17, 2003
CAMPGROUND PHONE (518) 251-5503

1. All Campers must obtain a camping permit from the campground supervisor.
2. No person under the age of 18 is eligible for a permit.
3. All permit applicants must product adequate identification and proof of age upon request, and furnish the full names of all person under 18 years of age in the party.
4. Permit holder is liable for any violations of campground rules and regulations.
5. No person under age 18 will be permitted to camp or occupy a campsite unless supervised by a member of the camping party who is age 18 or older.
6. One family per site, with maximum of four adults and no more than 8 persons.
7. A \$2.00 per night charge for additional people.
8. One approved camper or tent per site. In addition one portable screen house or 4 person tent is acceptable.
9. One platform not exceeding 10' X 12' is allowed.
10. No other structures of any type are permitted.
11. All personal property, including platforms, must be removed by permit expiration date.
12. Quiet hours to be observed from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m..
13. Generators must be operated from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. only.
14. Permanent water lines (hoses) are not permitted.
15. All gray water must be discharged through a 1 1/2" (max) waste line into a 5 gallon in - ground container properly surrounded by rocks and approved by the campground supervisor.
16. No gray water may be discharged on the surface of the ground.
17. All in-ground containers must be removed by campers when the site is vacated.
18. Speed limit in the campground is 5 MPH.
19. No unregistered vehicles allowed.
20. No unnecessary driving through the campground is permitted
21. Not more than two (2) motor vehicles may be parked at any site. All other vehicles must be parked at the public parking lot.
22. An adequate fire lane must be maintained at all times.

23. Garbage disposal is the responsibility of the campers. Disposal of most types of garbage is permitted at the Minerva Transfer Station. Sorting for recycling is required. Use your camping permit at the Transfer Station.
24. All pets must be leashed at all times. All dogs must be properly licensed and must be currently inoculated against rabies. Proof of full compliance will be required.
25. No cutting or defacing of trees, shrubs, rocks or building is permitted.
26. The campsite is to be kept clean at all times and must be thoroughly cleaned and picked up when the site is vacated.
27. No building of docks is allowed.
28. No overnight docking is allowed at the Town of Minerva docks.
29. No unauthorized user of the Town of Minerva electric outlets.
30. No person under the age 21 shall possess or consume alcoholic beverages within the campground. Anyone who possesses or consumes alcoholic beverages must produce identification and proof of age upon request.
31. Parents will be held responsible for any vandalism by their children and will be required to pay for any damages.
32. All persons shall comply with all lawful instructions of the campground supervisor, or any peace officer or police officer.
33. Violation of any provisions of these rules may result in forfeiture of camping rights.
34. The offending camper will be required to vacate their assigned campsite and remove all equipment from the Town of Minerva property. The Minerva Town Board will determine if any refund will be allowed at the first regularly scheduled Town Board meeting that occurs after the rule violation.
35. The Town of Minerva reserves the right to deny any camping permit based on past behavior or rule(s) violations
36. Failure to remove your camper at the close of the season, one (1) day past two (2) week grace period, will result in a \$5.00 per day additional charge – inclusive of the two (2) week grace period.
37. Moving a camper into the sites earlier than the opening date, as noted on the registration form, will result in a \$14.00 per day charge.
38. Use of fire crackers or fireworks is illegal and will result in the loss of camping privileges.
39. Firearms are not allowed on campsite property.
40. Forbid **All Terrain Vehicles (ATV's)** access to the Minerva Campground during the Summer Camping Season.
